


# Lesson 1.0

## Starting Adobe Photoshop, Opening Files, and Using tools


Welcome to Lesson 1.0 of Photoshop6 tutorials. This section will overview, Starting Photoshop, Opening files and viewing the tools.


This is the first window that will appear when you launch the program.



# Photoshop & Imageready:

Choose **file**, then **New** or **Open**. Choosing **New** means you would like to create an **Image**. **Open** means you want to open an **Image** that is already created.





When Choosing **New**, a window will come up asking for the **Name** of the file.


The **Width** and **Height** of the Image is the measurement of the image, which will be either pixels or inches).

**Resolution:** Mac is 72dpi and the PC is 96dpi for the Web or on screen. How many **Dots per inch** on the monitor your using.


The **Mode** is **RGB**(Red,Green,&Blue colors that are used to create web colors).Other Modes will be discussed at a later time.

The **Contents** choices are White, Background Color or Transparent.

**Notice that the working image opened up at 66.7% not 100% it can effect your work.**
